

What Will Be The Structure Of This Mini-Conference?

- This mini-conference is focused on providing information for individuals transitioning into the private investigation business following retirement and for those with lesser experience as an operator of a private investigation business.
- The entire mini-conference will be built around a common scenario wherein the attendees will be expected to work the investigation and related matters as they would within their own office.
- The structure of the mini-conference will include work groups for individual subject development and complementing lectures.
- Each work group with their elected leader will prepare and maintain a case file to document information received and activities undertaken during the course of their investigation.
- Class length will not be limited to the traditional one-hour lecture blocks but will be related to the material developed and lecture presentations. Appropriate breaks will be taken at least once every 90 minutes.
- Computers and audio/visual records will not be allowed in the classroom due to copyright restrictions.

- Handouts will be distributed at the end to each lecture.
- Class hours will be 8AM—12Noon and 1PM—5PM on Friday, November 12, 2010 and 8AM—12Noon and 1PM—4PM on Saturday, November 13, 2010. This is a total of 15 hours.
- Certificates of attendance will be issued to those requiring recertification hours or for similar purposes.
